



Directions to Crab Louie's Seafood Tavern

Crab Louie's is located in the Sycamore Square Shopping Village, in the 13500 block of Midlothian Turnpike, in the village of Midlothian. There is no physical address posted on or near the restaurant. Use the following landmarks to assist you in locating Sycamore Square:

Crab Louie's is located...

- eight miles west of Stonebridge Shopping Center
- five and a half miles west of the Arboretum and Comfort Inn
- four miles west of the Sheraton Park South
- three miles west of the Koger Center Holiday Inn Select
- two and a half miles west of the Chesterfield Towne Center
- one mile west of Wal-Mart
- catty corner from Midlothian Middle School
- one mile east of Midlothian High School



From Downtown Richmond

Take the Downtown Expressway north. After the first toll booth, stay to the left following the signs to the Powhite Parkway. After crossing the James River, stay to the right after the toll booth, following signs to "Route 76" (Powhite Parkway.) Take the Powhite until it ends near Brandermill. You will pass exits for Midlothian Tnpk., Courthouse Rd., and Route 288. The Powhite ends about one mile west of the intersection of 288, at a traffic light (Coalfield Rd.) Take Old Hundred Rd. to traffic light at Charter Colony Parkway. Turn right on to Charter Colony Parkway. Proceed about two and a half miles until it dead ends at Midlothian Tnpk. Turn right on to Midlothian Pike, turn left at the second traffic light, and take your immediate left into Sycamore Square. Crab Louie's is the second building on the left with a white picket fence and a red brick walkway leading to the entrance.

From the West End

Depending on where you are located in the West End ... Take I-64 or Patterson Avenue west to Route 288. Take Route 288 South to the Midlothian Turnpike Exit. Travel East on Midlothian Turnpike for about 1 mile. Turn left at the fifth traffic light and take your immediate left into Sycamore Square. Crab Louie's is the second building on the left with a white picket fence and a red brick walkway leading to the entrance.

From Chester, Petersburg, Colonial Heights and points south

Take I-95 north (if applicable) to Route 288 north. The last exit before 288 merges with Route 76 (Powhite Parkway,) is Old Hundred Rd. This exit is well marked. Take Old Hundred Rd. to traffic light at Charter Colony Parkway. Turn right on to Charter Colony Parkway. Proceed about two and a half miles until it dead ends at Midlothian Tnpk. Turn right on to Midlothian Pike, turn left at the second traffic light, and take your immediate left into Sycamore Square. Crab Louie's is the second building on the left with a white picket fence and a red brick walkway leading to the entrance.

From Richmond International Airport (I-64 West)

Take I-64 west to the Pocahontas Parkway (Route 895). After the Pocahontas Parkway toll plaza, travel north on the Chippenham Parkway. After traveling on the Chippenham Parkway, travel west on the Powhite Parkway. Take the Powhite until it ends about one mile west of the intersection of 288, at a traffic light (Charter Colony Parkway.) Turn right on to Charter Colony Parkway. Proceed about two and a half miles until it dead ends at Midlothian Tnpk. Turn right on to Midlothian Pike, turn left at the second traffic light, and take your immediate left into Sycamore Square. Crab Louie's is the second building on the left with a white picket fence and a red brick walkway leading to the entrance.

From Ashland

Take I-95 south, following the signs for the Powhite Parkway. After crossing the James River, stay to the right after the toll booth, following signs to "Route 76" (Powhite Parkway.) Take the Powhite until it ends near Brandermill. You will pass exits for Midlothian Tnpk., Courthouse Rd., and Route 288. The Powhite ends about one mile west of the intersection of 288, at a traffic light (Charter Colony Parkway). Turn right on to Charter Colony Parkway. Proceed about two and a half miles until it dead ends at Midlothian Tnpk. Turn right on to Midlothian Pike, turn left at the second traffic light, and take your immediate left into Sycamore Square.
